Rules for the Doubles tournament are:

1. Total percentage for both partners cannot exceed 100%.
2. It will be a mixed tournament, handicapped and without restrictions.
3. It will be six teams double round robin

with a break after the first round.

4. It will not be a walking doubles but partners may exchange shoes at mid-court.

5. 50-Shoe cancellation games. Entry fee \$10.00 per person. Payback to top three in each class.

August 16, 1998, (Sunday), the ANNUAL SALMON VALLEY SINGLES TOURNAMENT WILL BE HELD. This

tournament will start at 9 AM promptly. Pre-registration for tournament, a MUST not later than 9 PM August 13, 1998.

Our Annual Salmon Valley tournament will be held Sunday. If enough pitchers show up we will have classes which will be within 10% point spread. Classes A, B, C, D. Entry Fee
