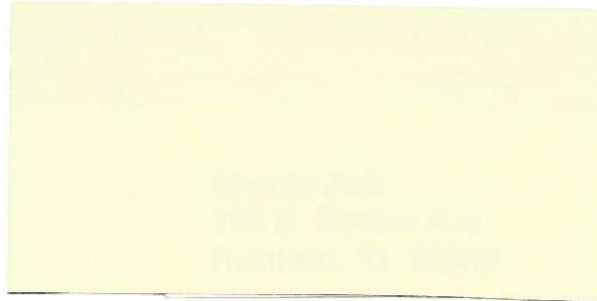

A. R. D. REPORT

As your Assistant Regional Director, I have been asked to provide periodic updates on events in our region, so I will now take this opportunity to bring you up to date.

I will begin by stating that membership numbers, as well as entries for all tournaments, have decreased when compared to previous years. Most tournaments averaged only 23 participants, and the overall Junior participation was very low. These numbers may improve due to the fact that Mountain Home and Twin Falls have rejoined the tournament schedule, though. However this potential gain could be counteracted by the loss of Coeur d' Alene should no one else pick it up.

On a more positive note, new clay courts were installed in Boise this year (though they may need to be

reconfigured due to the amount of water they receive from the park's sprinkler system), and Kellogg has a new pitching facility down the road from the old one.

Ainsworth, Nebraska, hosted the World Tournament this year. There were just over 900 entries, 5 hailing from Idaho. The Idaho representatives were myself (David Spears), Chelsie Spears, Jim Newton, John Warren and our former president, Henry Reid. Here is how each person did overall in his / her class.

Men F-1
David Spears, 8 1/2 wins, 6 1/2 losses, placed 9th.

Men L-1
John Warren, 3 wins, 12 losses, placed 16th.

Men N-1
Jim Newton, 9 wins, 6 losses, placed 4th.

Men Q-1
Henry Reid, 13 wins, 2 losses, placed 1st

Juniors D
Chelsie Spears, 0 wins, 15 losses, placed 16th.

Ainsworth welcomed all the horseshoe pitchers with open arms and the support group for the tournament was outstanding. With the exception of a few rain delays the first week, things ran very smooth.

The 1999 World Tournament will be held in Greenville, Ohio, and is expected to have one of the largest turnouts for World tournament. The bid for the year 2000 tournament went to Bismark, North Dakota.

ISHPA MINUTES

AUGUST 28, 1998  
RUPERT, IDAHO

Buck Walker spoke on co-operation of the Rupert Fairboard members and thanked them for their help and support.

David Spears thanked the Rupert people and the people who helped support the Rupert Club..

David Spears opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and then called the 1998 meeting to order.

The minutes and treasurers report from 1997 was read and accepted.

Jesse Lyda reported on the progress of the horseshoe pits in Kellogg. Jesse asked all the horseshoe pitchers to come up next year to one of the three tournaments.

Nominations for State Doubles were taken. Jim Price nominated Jackpot, NV, for State Doubles. Discussion was that the State Doubles should be held in Idaho. Bill

Rust stated that we should support our local businesses. Pocatello was nominated, seconded and passed for the 1999 State Doubles.

Nominations were taken for Idaho State Singles. Tim Seward nominated Salmon, seconded by Gary Opper. Jesse Lyda nominated Kellogg, seconded by Betty Lyda. Vote was in favor of Salmon for the 1999 State Tournament. Date was voted on and will be held the weekend before Labor Day.

Don Moser gave a short talk on the Eastern Idaho Fair and the Blind Doubles Draw to be held on the 10th of September.

Discussion on proper footwear. There is not a dress code for individual tournaments or for State Tournaments just World Tournament.

Article IV of our by-laws, games forfeited, was discussed and was removed from our by-laws. We can not overrule National by-laws, Section 12, blue book.

Dave Spears had discussion on Juniors receiving the Idaho State Plaque. Don Moser suggested that they wait until they become adults. Bob Zausch and Bill Rust agreed but thought that they should receive some kind of trophy. Dave made the motion to leave it up to the tournament director to give Juniors in Idaho State plaque and to take funds out of their own pocket..Seconded by Jim Price. Motion passed. If a Junior wants to pay and pitch 40 feet they will forfeit their Junior status.

Handicaps for tournaments were discussed. Dave thought that the same handicap should be statewide. Jim Price made a motion that it should be up to the

directors diecretion how they will do the handicap. It was seconded by Gary Opper and motion passed. Bob Riley suggested that everyone needs to know what you will use as percentage. Bonnie suggested that we need to pitch horseshoes for fun and not have to have everything out in front of you. Lynn J. Suggested that each tournament let 4 Dead know how tournament will be run. Motion made by Jim Price and seconded that we throw shoes in a handicapped tournament not by points. Passed.

Gary Opper asked for suggestions on how to draw in horseshoe pitchers.

Rules on alcoholic beverages and smoking were discussed.

Motion made by Buck Walker to pitch 30 and 40 foot pitchers together in one class according to percentage except for State Tournament. Motion seconded for

trial for one year by Gene Tarr. Motion passed.

Discussion on the number of sanctioned tournaments you must pitch to qualify to pitch in the State tournament. Article 7, #2, to qualify for state you must pitch in 2 sanction tournaments. Dave made the motion that you must pitch in 2 sanctioned tournaments from State to State to qualify. Motion seconded by Henry Reid. Motion carried and passed.

Ralph Ruebei discussed the lap top and ask for reimbursement to be made to Dave for the cost of the lap top. Motion made. Seconded and passed.

Ten year patches were give to Jim Newton, Don Heidt, Keith Thomas, and Vern Tieszen.

An award was given to Bonnie Stutzman for her support and dedication to the sport of horseshoe.

Tournament director of the year was given to Lynn Johnson, Salmon, ID.

Motion made by Gene Tarr that all the officers stay the same for the coming year. Suggested that we have a seconde vice president. Jesse Lyda nominated by Harry Chapin and seconded by Marge Chapin. Motion passed. All officers remain the same for one year including Jesse Lyda second vice president.

Door Prizes were drawn.

Meeting Adjourned.
