The State Doubles rules for 1994 were set at the Annual Meeting in Kellogg last August and they are as follows:

1. Total percentage of both partners cannot exceed 100%.
2. It will be a mixed tourney without restrictions.
3. It will be a six-team double round robin. There will be a break after the first round (five games) before the final round.
4. It will not be a walking doubles but partners may exchange shoes at midcourt.
5. 50-shoe cancellation games.

Entry fee is \$12.50 for the Championship with payback to the top three in each class. The Saturday Classic entry fee is \$10.00. A great variety of fine food will be available both days. A very special menu is planned for Sunday starting with coffee and donuts early and followed by great German and Polish sausages, Bar-B-Qued beef sandwiches and all the trimmings.

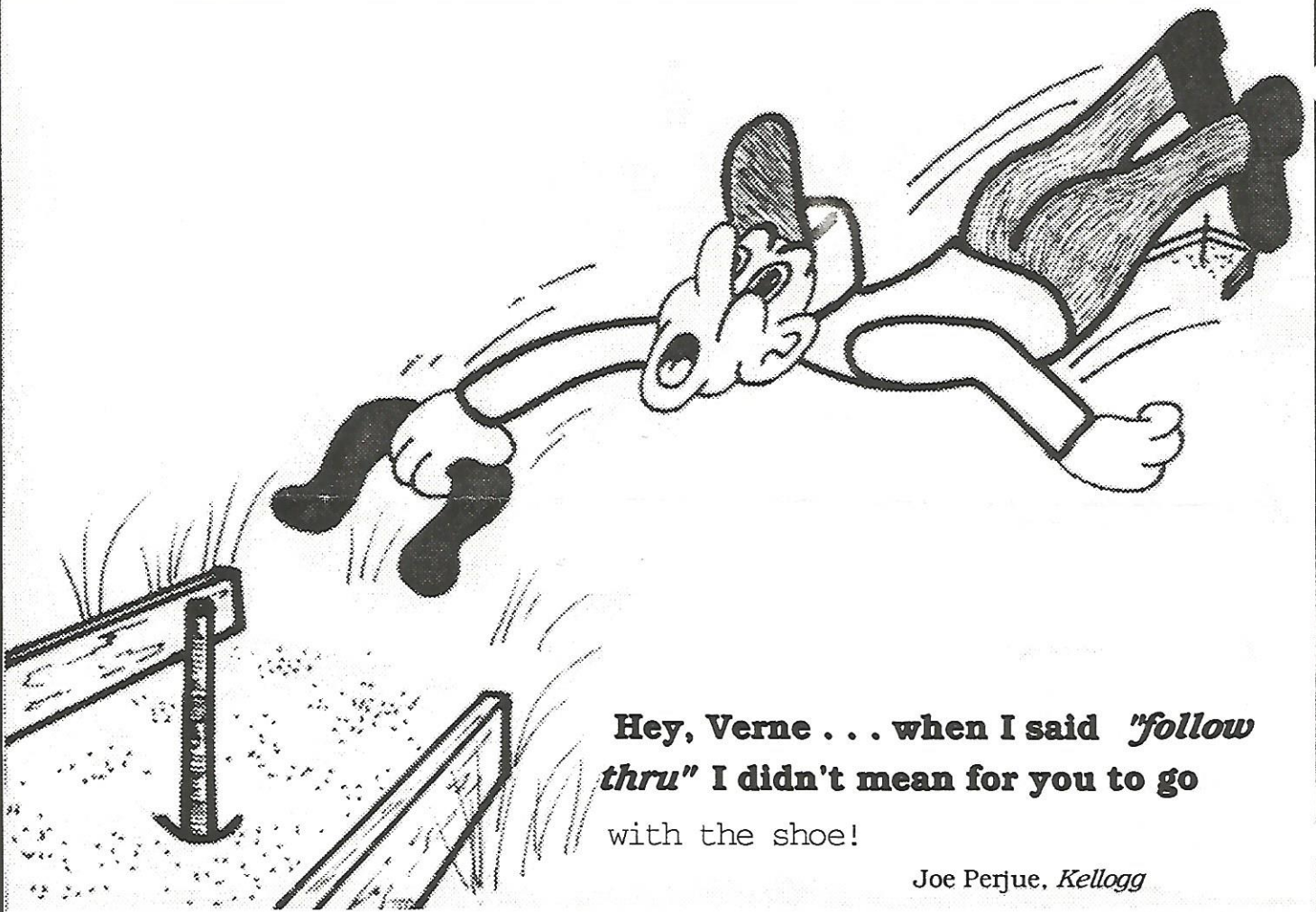
