Regional Director Message



Any contestant without a current ringer average at their pitching distance shall pitch a minimum of one hundred (100) consecutive shoes on a sanctioned court to establish their tournament seeding percentage. This qualifying must be scored in writing and witnessed by two (2) NHPA

members no more than thirty (30) days prior to the entry deadline. Alternately, NHPA Sanctioned League ringer percentage averages may be used if they are based on one hundred (100) or more shoes. This rule for pitching 100 shoes to qualify to pitch in a tournament is deviated by many, and as your Regional Director I ask that you please, when qualifying new people or those moving them up to 30 feet, please qualify them with the 100 shoe count.

The NHPF (National Horseshoe Pitching Foundation) has recently mentioned to me that grants are available for new court construction and court modification. Grants that are currently being given out are \$1,500.00, so if you have a facility that is in need of work or modification it may be worthwhile looking into filling out the form under the NHPF and submitting it.

With the completion of 2013 around the corner now may be a good time to reach out and ask those tournament directors to start working on dates for the 2014 season. This year the schedule was not really finalized until March, and since I have to order the sanction certificates and patches I would like to request the dates be turned in by the end of January. At the world tournament we voted in a new Vice President that oversees us Regional Directors, and since he will be new to this position I would like to give him a little lead time on taking patch and certificate orders.

Much discussion at the world tournament during the state officers meeting concerned trying to get new members into the organization and how to go about doing it. One suggestion brought up was putting on a Basic Horseshoe Pitching Class and advertise through the different social outlets trying to mainly focus on the kids. With this suggestion in mind, I personally have decided to take on the challenge here in Boise and create what I call "Intro to Horseshoe Pitching." The class I am going to do

needs fine tuning but my intent is to touch on how horseshoe pitching first came about and how it has progressed over time and to "more or less" do a show and tell along with instructions. I am asking Pep Plummer of Boise to help me out with the creation of this program along with possibly others. My intent is to start this in the Spring of 2014.

As we near the end of the Pitching season this may be a good time to check out our courts for the proper specs of the pegs. Making adjustments when the pegs are out of spec is sometimes over looked, but as I try and remind everyone, we all appreciate a well kept-up facility. Once again as a reminder, the pegs from the front at ground level should be forty feet, and the peg height should be no less that 14 inches and no higher than 15 inches, and the pegs should have a 12 degree lean on each peg or a 3 inch lean toward the opposing peg from the top of the peg to the bottom of the peg at ground level.

World Tournament Results

Idaho Pitchers

Idaho sent 46 pitchers to the World Tournament in St. George, Utah this summer. The Idaho presence was seen and felt as the masses proudly wore Idaho shirts, and many folks helped with score keeping and after hours cleanup. A particularly large shout-out goes to Arthur Ross and Doug Palmer who both worked tirelessly in the statroom and were seen on the courts late at night with brooms in their hands.



The clay was problematic to some but was equal for all. Alan Francis (OH) didn't complain much as he walked off with his 18th Men's Championship while pitching a WT record 91.28% ringer percentage during the 15 game Championship round. He is such a magnificent pitcher and gentleman. He also tossed two perfect games just for good measure.

Cindy Hoffman (PA) won her first WT title beating out four time defending champion Joan Elmore while pitching only 69.63%. The last woman's Champ to pitch under 70% was in 1963.

The Elders Champ was Ed Arionus (TX) who pitched 73.67% while winning his fifth title. Ed also has won two Senior's title over the years.

Ron Deckard won the Senior Men's title for the fifth time pitching 59.11%. The last time the title was won while pitching under 60% was 2002.

Sheila Shepard (CO) pitched a fine 71.61% in winning the Senior Woman's title but this too was the lowest in six years.

Dalton Rakestraw (MO) won his second straight Boy's title but pitched only 72.09% following last year's fine 87.65%

Canadian Lindsay Hodgins won the Girl's Championship pitching 56.91%.

Cadet Steven Lazaris (WI) upset defending Champion Ryan Schepers and pitched the best percentage ever with a 54.07%. This was expected since the Cadet age was raised this year by three years.
