## President's Message

Members,



Well, Melanie and I just returned from another World Tournament, this one at the Lansing Center in Lansing, Michigan. Melanie took 2nd in her class and I finished 7th in mine. I lost some that I shouldn't have, but I know what I was doing wrong and will be practicing for our

State Singles coming the end of August. I look forward to seeing everyone there!

There were several NHPA Rule & Bylaw changes submitted. Here is their recap:

**PRC #1** was proposing to create a new women's Elder division that would give them a new pitching distance (one step from 27 ft foul line that got modified to the 20 ft foul line). It didn't get 2/3rds majority. FAILED

**PRC #2 Requirement 3 - Charter/State Information; Section A - State Championship Play**

This proposal took out the wording that you must reside in the state and changed it to meeting the resident eligibility requirements of the Charter Bylaws to pitch in their State Tournaments. Charters now control who they allow to pitch in their State Tournaments. PASSED

**PRC #3 Rule 11; Section D**

This proposal changed the requirement to have 2 NHPA members verify new members pitching their 100 shoes while qualifying, to only 1 NHPA member. PASSED

**PRC #4 III Guidelines; Section - A Regular Doubles**

This proposal took out wording of who starts the game and pitches first and added wording that the Tournament Director shall determine who pitches first and what pitching rotation to use in each game. PASSED

## ISHPA 2023

### State Singles Tournament

**PRC #5 III Guidelines; Section B - Walking doubles; 1. Shoe-limit games**

This proposal also changed the wording of who pitches first by allowing the Tournament Director to determine who throws first and what rotation to use while pitching. PASSED

**PRC #6 III Guidelines; Section B Walking Doubles; 2. Point limit games**

This proposal made the same changes as the previous section. PASSED

**PRC #7 & #8**

These rule changes allow for non-members to be allowed to pitch as pacers during tournament and League play. PASSED

**PBC #1**

This proposal just added the wording “electronic meetings” by any means available. PASSED

**PBC #2 Article V; Officers; Section 5**

This proposal made a wording change from “will receive” to “may request” a travel allowance which then is approved by the President with council consent and approval. PASSED

**PBC #3 Article V; Officers; Section 8**

This Proposal was adding a term limit of three consecutive terms to all officers on the council. FAILED

**PBC # 4**

No vote due to PBC #3 failed.

**PBC #5 Article III; Section 7**

This proposal modified the place to buy your NHPA membership and added a statement that a member can request an exception that will be reviewed by the council to buy their membership in a different charter from where they reside. PASSED

The above Rule and Bylaw changes will take effect immediately due to a standing rule passed by the Council at the meeting on August 1. New Rule Books will be printed and electronic copies will also be available on the NHPA website.

The World Tournament in Lansing, Michigan was a great success. We had some issues and problems that come with holding a major tournament, but we made it through and we crowned 2023 Champions.

The 2024 World Tournament will be in Kennewick, WA July 29 - August 10, 2024. You need to have pitched in a minimum of 4 sanctioned tournaments in the twelve months prior to May 15, 2024. So, make a plan to get your 4 tournaments in so that you can send in your application and make this tournament one of the largest ones in attendance.

At our Annual Business meeting to be held on Saturday of this year’s State Singles tournament, we will be reviewing and approving the minutes of last year’s meeting which are in the [Fall 2022](#) issue of “Four Dead.”

We are all trying to promote and grow this sport and bring our numbers up; it takes us all to be talking to our family and friends to let them know what a great activity this is and that anyone can pitch with us!
